

How To: Clean a WaterHog®

Regularly scheduled maintenance ensures mats are clean and able to remove the maximum amount of contaminants entering your building.

Vacuum

Vacuum regularly; daily in high-traffic commercial areas, weekly in lower traffic areas. A slower paced vacuum speed is recommended since the dirt is below the surface level.

Shake Off

To remove larger dirt particles, take the mat outside and shake off to dislodge debris trapped below the surface level.

Hose, Pressure Wash, or Extract

WaterHog mats can be hosed off, pressure washed, or extracted to remove contaminants. Use a light to medium setting. The nozzle should be 12 inches from mat surface and apply even strokes.

A mild detergent can be used for difficult stains.

Hang mat to dry. Ensure the mat is dry before placing back in service.
