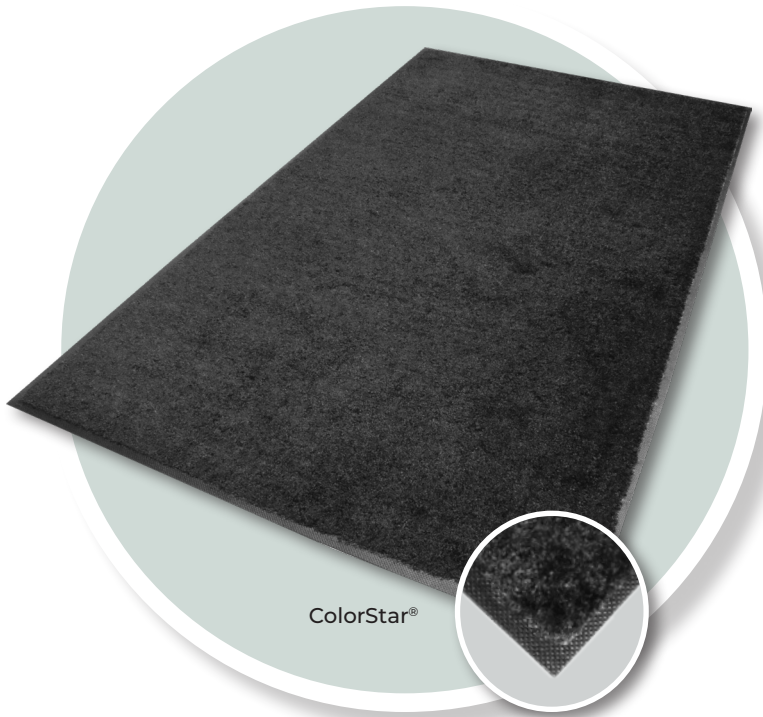

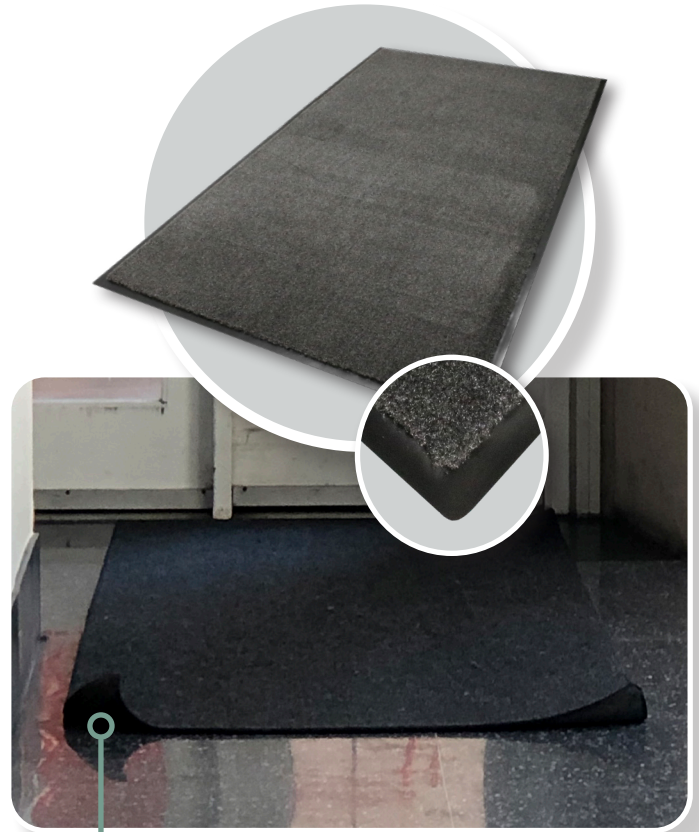

## COST OF OWNERSHIP

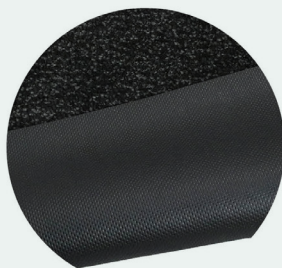

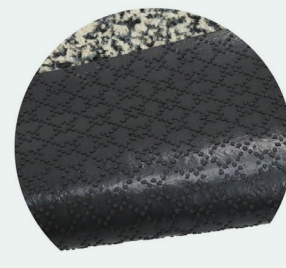
## Rubber Backing Types



**Smooth Backing**  
Recommended for smooth floors  
(like marble, wood, tile)



**Cleat Plus Backing**  
Recommend for carpeted floors



**Universal Cleated Backing**  
Designed to perform on both carpeted  
and smooth floors
